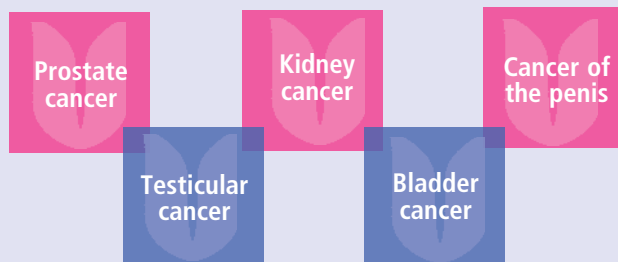


UCARE (Urology Cancer Research and Education) was founded by a group of clinicians, patients and supporters who care about fighting urological cancer.

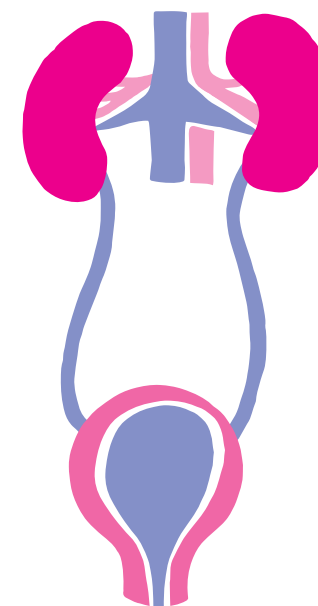

What is urological cancer?

Urological cancer is cancer that affects the kidney, bladder, prostate, testicles or penis.

What are the symptoms?

The symptoms below can be caused by conditions other than cancer. If you are experiencing any of these symptoms, you should see your GP who may refer you for further investigation.

Kidney cancer

Kidney cancer often causes no symptoms and is found as an incidental finding on a routine scan.

Specific symptoms include:

- blood in the urine
- pain or swelling in the loin

Non-specific symptoms, common to many cancers, include:

- weight loss
- fatigue
- night sweats

Bladder cancer

The most common symptom of bladder cancer is blood in the urine, but there can also be:

- pain passing urine
- increase in frequency of passing urine

Testicular cancer

Early symptoms of testicular cancer are usually a lump or swelling in one testicle, which may or may not be accompanied by an ache or heavy sensation. Occasionally there may be swelling with extreme tenderness.

Prostate cancer

Prostate cancer does not usually cause symptoms in the early stages. When symptoms do occur, they may include:

- difficulty or pain when passing urine
- a need to pass urine more frequently, particularly during the night
- blood in the urine

Note that these symptoms can be a sign of non-cancerous prostate enlargement.

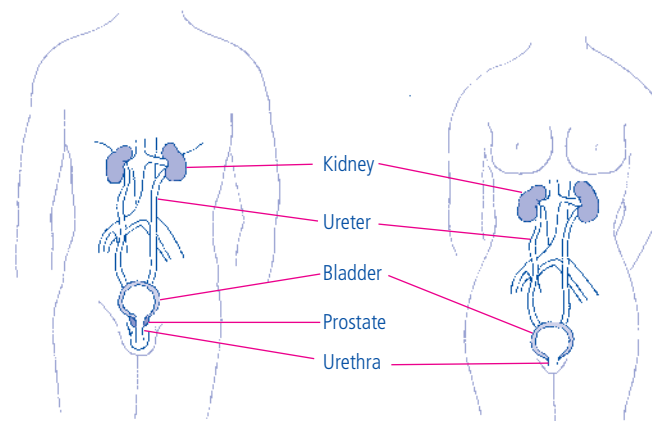
Cancer of the penis

The first signs of cancer of the penis are usually changes in the skin, either:

- thickening
- growths or sores

Clinical trials

You may be offered a potentially different treatment option as part of a clinical trial. The aim of a clinical trial is to develop new treatments, which are always being investigated.



If you have any symptoms or concerns, don't be embarrassed and don't delay – visit your doctor and get checked out.

Research is often complicated, time-consuming and expensive but it provides hope for patients and their families, and leads to more effective ways of treating and preventing cancer. **Please help by giving what you can.**
